**Description:** Life Space Crisis Intervention (LSCI) is a pragmatic approach to dealing with aggressive and problematic behaviors within the school setting. Based on the latest research, this training is designed to teach professionals skills for de-escalating problematic/dangerous behavior in their school. This training is designed for those directly involved in crisis situations (administrators, counselors, etc.) and those working frequently with aggressive/emotionally impaired students. LSCI is also an excellent training for teachers who may be having difficulty with problem behaviors in their classroom. LSCI offers a diversity of new skills to even the most experienced professional. This training leads to certification by the Life Space Crisis Intervention Institute. Three semester hours of graduate credit are available.

For educators/youth workers within Charlevoix-Emmet ISD there is no cost to the participant unless you choose not to complete the program, which will result in a \$100 materials charge. For educators/youth workers outside Charlevoix-Emmet ISD, participants will be charged \$495 plus materials.
