- A process that guides rich dialogue using data around student strengths, preferences, interests, areas of needs and available resources in the areas of housing, daily living, community access/participation, employment/volunteering, and education/training.
- Revisited annually and helps guide IEP.
- Plan for two-hour meeting when completing initial process.
