

PBIS Coaches' Academy

These sessions are open to all ISD & school coaches. They provide a venue for coaches to deepen their knowledge about PBIS data, systems, and practices as well as provide opportunities to problem-solve common barriers to implementation. Additionally, Coaching Service Delivery Plans will be

PBIS Data Review COACHING SUPPORT SESSIONS (CSS)

This session is designed for all coaches to prepare for their schools' data reviews. PBIS school coaches, in collaboration with their Char-Em ISD PBIS Coach(es), will identify and analyze available data, enter school-level data in the MIDATA system, prepare visual displays of data, and practice problem solving for their school's Data Dialog process meeting SCECHs are available for all sessions. PBIS Data Review SCHOOL LEADERHIP TEAMS (SLT)

These sessions are designed for COHORT 2 School Leadership Teams (SLT): Charlevoix Elementary; Ellsworth Elementary; and East Jordan Elementary and MSHS, though other cohorts may participate (contact your ISD coach to discuss). SLTs, in collaboration with their Char-Em ISD PBIS Coach(es), will analyze behavioral data from multiple sources to determine needed changes and next steps in their PBIS implementation. Teams will also have the opportunity to explore resources and tools for supporting a more durable and sustainable PBIS system and outline their activities in their PBIS implementation plans. PBIS Leadership Forum (Online)

This three-day online forum (Oct. 26-28) is a technical assistance activity of the Center on PBIS and provides an opportunity for the Center to share information on the latest applications of PBIS. It has been designed to help school, state, district, and regional Leadership Teams and other professionals increase the effectiveness of school environments through PBIS.

Tier 3 Scope and Sequence

These sessions are designed for schools who have already attended the Tier 1 and Tier 2 sequences. They cover the critical features for readiness to install, implement, and coordinate an efficient, effective, equitable, and sustainable Tier 3 behavior system in order to improve outcomes for students needing intensive behavioral support. Included in these trainings are the process for determining the need for Functional Behavior Assessment (FBA) and the critical elements of quality Behavior Intervention Plans. Additionally, these sessions include a review of comprehensive Tier 3 strategies and interventions, specific resources for the prevent, teach and respond structure and effective de-escalation strategies across the cycle of behavioral escalation. <u>PBIS Cultural Responsiveness Field Guide: Resources for</u> Trainers and Coaches

This field guide outlines an integrated framework to embed equity efforts into school-wide positive behavioral interventions and supports (SWPBIS) by aligning culturally responsive practices to the core components of SWPBIS. The goal of using this guide is to make school systems more responsive to the cultures and communities that they can



systems more responsive to the cultures and communities that they serve. This guide is part of a 5-point intervention approach for enhancing equity in student outcomes within a SWPBIS approach.

10 Strategies to Combat Stress in the Classroom
